We visit a lodge run exclusively by the San, the bushmen of southern Africa. And the Chobe National Park, which holds abundant amounts of elephants. We then make our way to the Makgadikgadi salt pan in northeast Botswana – the cradle of Homo Sapiens. Here we visit meerkats, zebras, and take in the views at the breathtaking Victoria falls.
