Only very few Western journalists go to Syria nowadays – it's too dangerous. We follow Anwar, a former teacher who began helping the opposition as an unarmed activist. But bloodshed and brutality spark a gradual and fundamental change in him. All that's left over is the wish for a new, divine law, to sweep away the tyranny of the Assad regime.
